

The 20th Annual Gulfstream Regatta November 5th, 2011 OFFICIAL NOTICE AND CONDITIONS OF RACE

The 20th Annual Gulfstream Regatta will be held in Ft. Lauderdale, Florida, on Saturday November 5th, 2011. The organizing authority is the Gulfstream Sailing Club.

1. GOVERNING RULES

The race will be governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2009-2012 including US Sailing Prescriptions, the PHRF-SEF Rules and Regulations, this Notice and Conditions of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The Regatta will be open to any single-hulled, self-righting, enclosed-cabin sailing boat with a self-draining cockpit, and to any offshore multihull that conforms to its class rules and holds a current, valid rating certificate as described below, with a crew of at least three people. All boats must carry a working VHF radio.

A valid 2011 PHRF SEF rating is required for PHRF boats. PHRF-SEF crew limitations are not in effect for this regatta. For ARC and GUNKHOLE cruising classes, ratings will be assigned by the Race Committee.

3. REGISTRATION

Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee, the signed waiver and appropriate rating certificates to:

All registrations must be completed and in the hands of the Race Committee no later than 1830,

4. CLASSES

It is our intention to include Classes as follows: PHRF, ARC, GUNKHOLE and ONE DESIGN at the discretion of the Race Committee.

If there are five or more boats of one design, the class will have its own start.

If there are fewer than five entries in either the ARC or GUNKHOLE class, these yachts will start and be scored as one ARC class.

6. RACES

The racing area will be in the Atlantic Ocean, and the Starting Area will be approximately 1 nm. North of Port Everglades.

Two races are scheduled. One race constitutes a regatta.

The penalty for breaking a rule of Part 2 for the ARC and GUNKHOLE classes shall be one turn including one tack and one gybe. This changes Rule 44.1 and 44.2 for these classes only.
