



**The Annual Gulfstream Sailing Club Regatta**  
**April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2014**  
**OFFICIAL NOTICE AND CONDITIONS OF RACE**

The Annual Gulfstream Sailing Club Regatta will be held in Ft. Lauderdale, Florida, on Saturday April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2014. The organizing authority is the Gulfstream Sailing Club.

**1. GOVERNING RULES**

The race will be governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2013-2016 including US Sailing Prescriptions, the PHRF-SEF Rules and Regulations, this Notice and Conditions of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

**2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

The Regatta will be open to any single-hulled, self-righting, enclosed-cabin sailing boat with a self-draining cockpit, and to any offshore multihull that conforms to its class rules and holds a current, valid rating certificate as described below, with a crew of at least three people. All boats must carry a working VHF radio.

A valid 2014 PHRF SEF rating is required for PHRF boats. PHRF-SEF crew limitations are not in effect for this regatta.

For ARC and ARC NON-SPINNAKER classes, ratings will be assigned by the Race Committee.

**3. REGISTRATION**

All registrations must R.S.V.P. **no later than 18:30, Wednesday, April 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2014.**

**4. CLASSES**

It is our intention to include classes as follows: ARC SPINNAKER, ARC NON-SPINNAKER, and PHRF at the discretion of the Race Committee. More classes may be designated upon discretion of Race Committee. *If there are fewer than three entries in any class, these yachts will start and be scored as one ARC class.*

The racing area will be in the Atlantic Ocean, and the starting area will be approximately 1 nautical mile south of the Commercial Boulevard Fishing. Two races are scheduled. One race constitutes a regatta.
